

1. Packungsinhalt

Die Ethernet Switch XON1300.S(C) dient als Endteilnehmerzugang in FTTH-Netzwerken. Er terminiert die optischen Daten und TV Signale und wandelt diese in elektrische Signale um. Diese Installationsanleitung zeigt Ihnen, wie sie den XON1300.S(C) in die bereits installierte Wandhalterung XON30.W mechanisch verbauen und anschließend in Betrieb nehmen. Um Probleme zu vermeiden, lesen Sie bitte die gesamte Installationsanleitung durch.

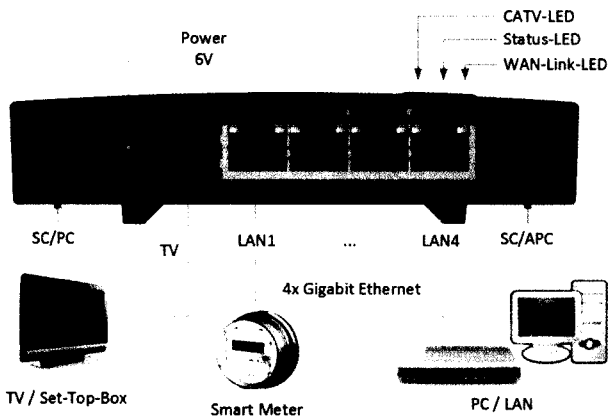
2. Installation und Beschreibung

a) Montagehinweise

Bei der Installation sind folgende Punkte zu beachten:

- Der XON1300.S(C) **darf nur** in dem dafür vorgesehenen Wandgehäuse XON30.W verbaut und mit dem **beiliegenden Netzteil** betrieben werden.
- Fassen Sie unter keinen Umständen auf die Stirnflächen der optischen Steckverbinder und Kupplungen.
- Schützen Sie den XON1300.S(C) vor Feuchtigkeit und Wasser.

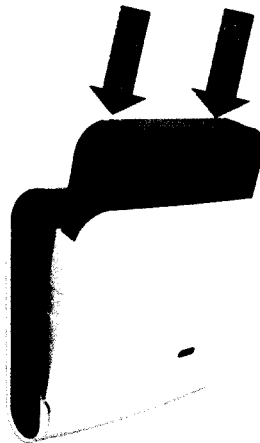
b) Anschlussübersicht XON1300.S(C)



c) Installation

Die Installation erfolgt in drei Schritten. Halten Sie bitte in jedem Fall die Reihenfolge der Installationsschritte ein.

1. Öffnen Sie die Klappe des Wandgehäuses XON30.W und ziehen Sie die beiden roten Dreiecke heraus.
2. Entfernen Sie nun die beiden Schutzkappen der SC/PC und SC/APC Buchsen auf der Rückseite des XON1300.
3. Führen Sie nun den XON1300 in die aufgeklappte Wandhalterung. Achten Sie darauf, dass die Anschlüsse nach unten zeigen und die Führungsschienen nach hinten. Drücken Sie den XON1300 vorsichtig an den oberen beiden Ecken in die Wandhalterung, bis Sie das Einrasten der beiden optischen Steckverbinder hören. Klappen Sie zuletzt das Wandgehäuse zu.



Nachdem Sie das Netzteil mit dem XON1300 verbunden haben, startet das Gerät. Die Geräte benötigen eine kurze Startphase.
